6. Oil



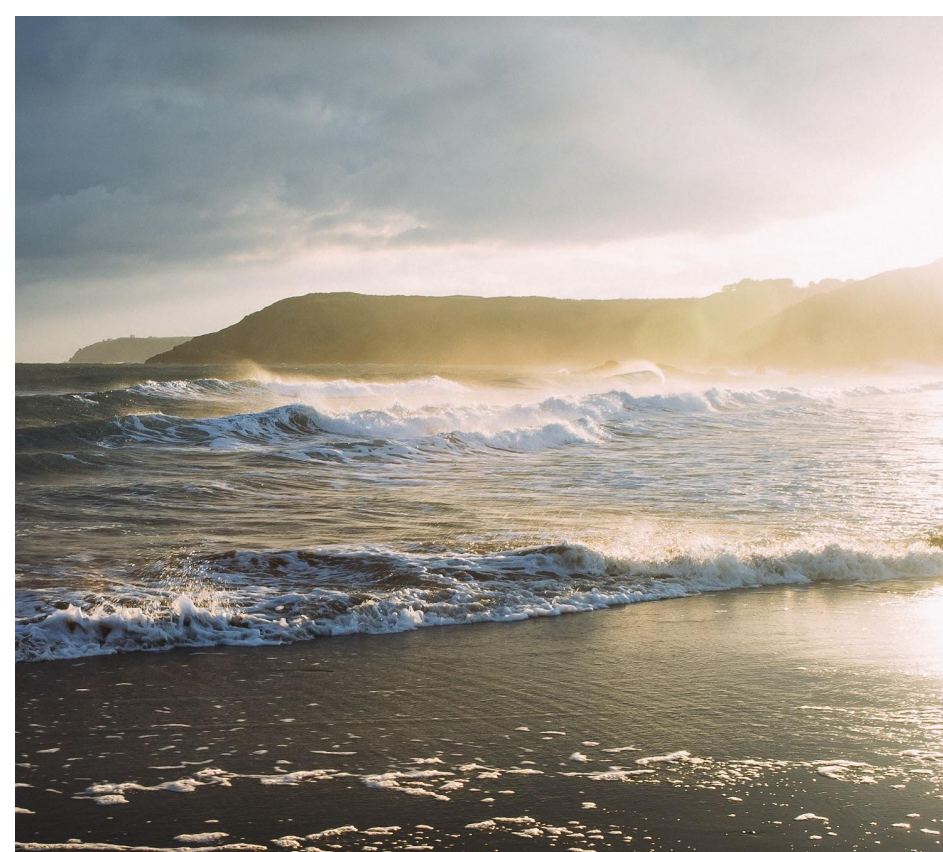


# Make your own light
