Work is a job that will be considered difficult or a burden for women compared to men. This is because women have a weaker nature than men, only a few strong women strive to achieve it more than men.

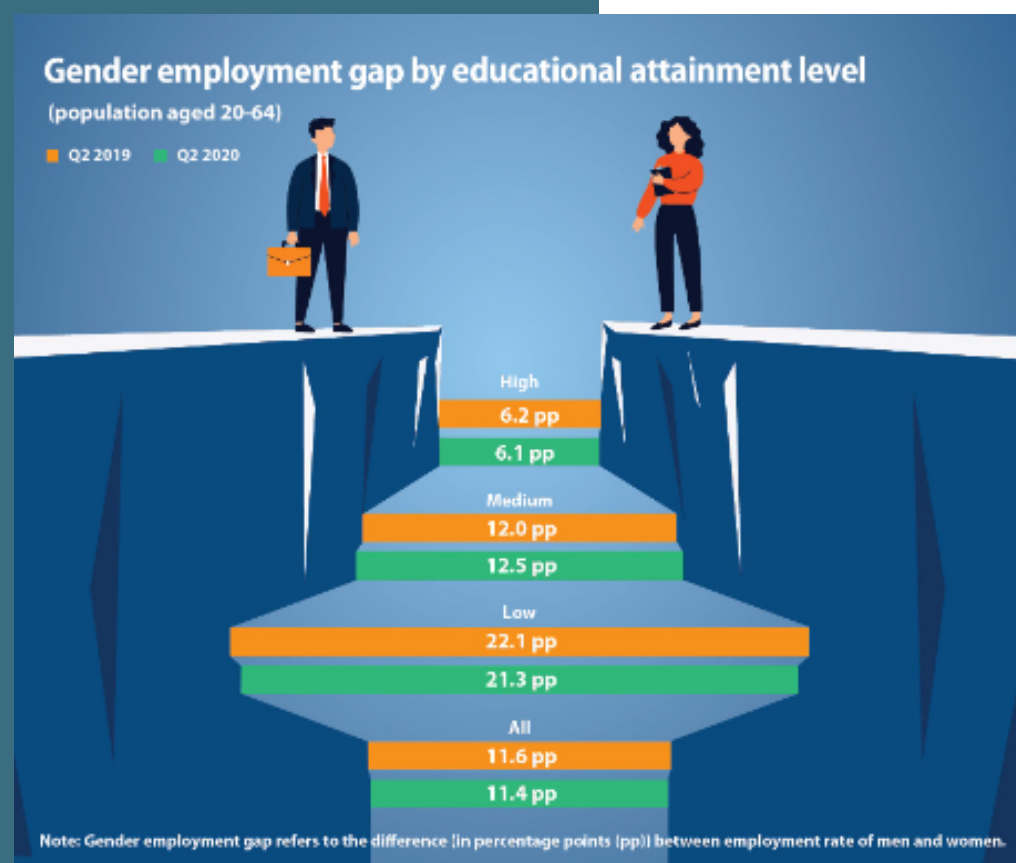
## BENEFITS EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT
