

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


RESEARCH BACKGROUND

• While international chain hotels have received the majority of research focus, this study takes the initiative to comprehensively analyse the effects of COVID-I9 in the context of independent hotels.

The owner of the hotel has the freedom to operate the business differently and promote the hotel property based on its uniqueness (O'Neill & Carlbäck, 2011). Study by Ozdemir, Dogru, Kizildag, Mody and Suess (2021) stated that independent hotels are deemed to be more susceptible to the adverse effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.
This vulnerability can be attributed to their lack of financial resources and infrastructure support, which are often available to larger hotel companies managing chains or franchises.





RESEARCH OBJECTIVES AND RESEARCH QUESTIONS

RESEARCH QUESTION I:

What strategies are implemented by the independent hotels dealing with the intra-pandemic?

RESEARCH OBJECTIVE I:

To identify the strategies taken by independent hotels during and after the COVID-19 pandemic;

RESEARCH OBJECTIVE 2:

What practices are implemented by the independent hotels dealing with the intra-pandemic?

RESEARCH OBJECTIVE 2:

To examine the practices adopted by these hotels in their business operations



RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

Source of data (primary and secondary data)

Qualitative study- explore the essence knowledge of the survival strategies and practices

An interpretivism-oriented approach - to study the independent hotels' view and knowledge dealing with the pandemic impacts

Target population and location of study: 3-5 star independent hotels that operated before the pandemic and during the pandemic until the data collection period located in Kota Kinabalu, Sabah

 Participants' view on the strategies employed to survive the independent hotels' businesses during the pandemic.

The defensive strategies of lowering operational costs were effective, which also highlighted in many literature studies on health-related crises ((Lo et al., 2006; Kim et al., 2005; Loi et al., 2021; Hao et al., 2020).
