

The state-of-the-art marine museum is yet another addition to the Universiti Malaysia Sabah campus.

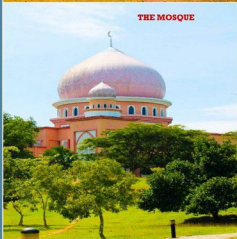

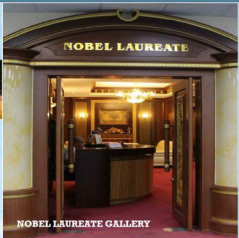

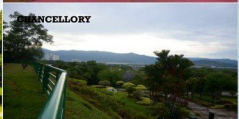

The Chancellery is responsible for marketing and implementing the idea of the vice-chancellor.


Scenery from the Chancellery building is breathtaking. We can see the breezes of flora from the front side and from the back of the building we can see the view of the beach.

CHANCELLOR HALL

The hall inspired by the shape of the gong was first used in 2003. The beauty and uniqueness of the board of chancellors can be seen not only through the art of construction, but also from outside the building.



Chancellor hall can accommodate about 5000 people at a time and used for university functions, such as registration of new students, orientation week and pledge ceremony convocation ceremonies.

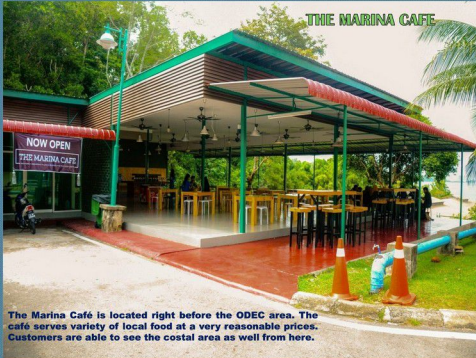

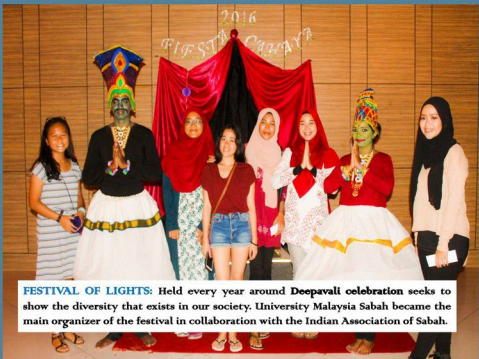


The Marina Café is located right before the ODEC area. The café serves variety of local food at a very reasonable prices. Customers are able to see the costal area as well from here.
